There is no lab this week. Your homework for this week is to get ready for CS103 Lab next week by doing the following:

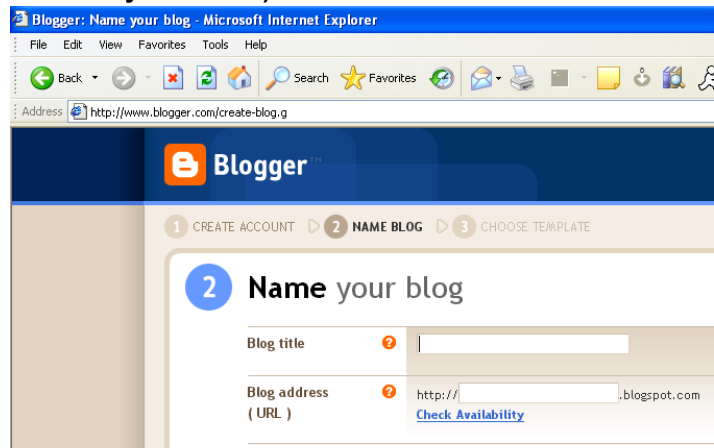
Read Web 101 Chapters 1, 2

Register for a CS Department computer account (if you don't already have one)

1. Go to Undergraduate CS Lab, Engineering Manufacturing Annex, 730 Comm Ave, Room 302
2. Ask Help Desk for a computer account
3. You will receive a CS.BU.EDU account and email address
4. You will also receive a Windows NT account via email from the Help Desk

Create a blog on Blogger.com (if you don't already have one)

1. Using your favorite Web browser, go to <http://blogger.com>
2. Follow the instructions to "create your blog now." You may use any name/pseudonym and email address that you wish when creating your blog.
3. Blogger.com will ask you for a blog title, a blog address (URL), and lots of other optional information. Feel free to customize your blog or not.
4. Write at least one post on your blog about anything you want



From your CS Department account, write an email to hmorcos@cs.bu.edu with the subject "CS103" and the following information in the body of the email:

1. Your name
2. Your blog title
3. Your blog address (URL). This will look like "http://-----.blogspot.com"
4. How long it took you to complete this homework assignment

For example, the body of your email might say

```
Joan Smith  
The Smith Chronicles  
http://smithchron.blogspot.com  
1 hour
```

This homework is worth 10 points:
