Instructions for Google Colaboratory

- 1. Open your browser, log into Piazza and access **Resources** on the CS237 Piazza page. You can also click on https://piazza.com/bu/spring2023/cascs237/resources or copy and paste the link.
- 2. Look for a section named **Homework** to download your programming assignment, as shown in the image bellow. All programming assignments have the file extension .ipynb, also known as Python Notebook. Click on the name of the Python Notebook and save it in your computer.
